45 MINUTES 17 SEPTEMBER 2018

47 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MEETING ON 17 SEPTEMBER 2018

Highway Issues in Dunderaw – A response had been received from the MP's Office advising that the Highways Network Manager would contact the Parish Council to arrange a site meeting to go through the various issues raised. The Chairman confirmed that a Highways Officer had been in contact but a date for the meeting was still to be arranged.

Odour emanating from slurry lagoon – The Clerk reported that the Borough Council's Environmental Protection department had been contacted regarding the odour emanating from the slurry lagoon on the B5302. The Borough Council's advice on any action the farmer could take to reduce the odour had been sought. No response had been received. Cllr Hedworth was requested to follow this up.

Registration at Information Commissioners Office – The Parish Council is now registered at the ICO.

48 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Allerdale Speed Limit Review 2018 – Waverbridge. Two residents from Waverbridge were in attendance and requested the parish council's support in opposing the proposal to increase the speed limit through Waverbridge to 40mph. Members agreed to respond to the consultation opposing the proposal.

Highway issues in the parish were discussed and will be raised when the Highways Officer visits the Parish.
